## Personal Visits

Family Support Specialists share age-appropriate child information, help parents learn to observe and interact with their own children, address parenting concerns, and engage the family in activities that provide meaningful parent-child interaction.

## Screening

Periodic screenings provides for early identification of physical, social or emotional delays or problems. Regular review of each family's progress identifies strengths and abilities as well as areas of concern that may require referral and follow-up services while increasing the parent's understanding of typical development.

## Resource Network

Family Support Specialists help families identify and connect with needed resources and agencies.
