Sight for Students



This Program is sponsored by Prevent Blindness Ohio and the Ohio Department of Health to help families pay for eye exams and glasses for students who qualify.

Applications can be made through the Trumbull County Combined Health District by calling 330-675-2489 and choosing option #3 for the nursing division.

Criteria:

1. Applicants family income is no more than 200% of Federal Poverty guidelines.
2. Child is not enrolled in Medicaid or other Vision Insurance.
3. Child is 19 years of age or younger.
4. Child is a U.S. citizen or resident alien.

Application Process:

1. When a family calls for information, the medical assistant/secretary talks with the family and sends an application form and letters explaining the Sight for Students program.
2. The parent completes the highlighted portion of the application, signs, and dates, and returns it to us in the self-addressed envelope.
3. If the applicant is eligible, a voucher packet will be sent to us and we in turn will mail it to the family with a letter and form to return after seeing a physician so we can complete our records for Prevent Blindness Ohio.
