Another Successful Half-Day Staff Training at the TCCHD.

The TCCHD recently held their annual half-day staff training outlined within the Quality Improvement plan, on June 30th, 2023. All available staff within the TCCHD attended the training, and the topics covered included:

- Quality Improvement, including the culture of quality within the TCCHD,
- Cultural Competency,
- Dur Branding Policy and Marketing Campaigns,
- Workforce Development, focusing on increased camaraderie and work/life balance,
- And building emergency response plans.

TCCHD staff were polled (via digital survey) for two weeks afterwards, to gather their feedback about the training, and this what they reported:

- 3.3 out of 4 possible stars for the quality of material covered,
- 3.3 out of 4 possible stars for overall experience,
- 75% of survey respondents felt the content covered met and exceeded their expectations,
- 3.3 out of 4 possible stars for personal experience during the training,

The TCCHD administration would like to extend a sincere "Thank you" to all the TCCHD staff. Your attendance, and active engaged participation in both the staff trainings, and subsequent evaluations makes the whole process easy for us, and enables the us to continue to provide training(s) that are relevant, interesting, and thought provoking for you all.

Covid-19 Data:

As of July 1st of 2023:

- The TCCHD has administered approximately 43,605 doses of the Covid-19 Vaccine.
- 20,937 are first doses,
- 17,862 are second doses,
- **3,426** are monovalent first booster doses,
- 532 are monovalent second booster doses,
- and **848** are bivalent boosters (original and Omicron),
- In June of 2023, the TCCHD gave 11 Covid vaccines,
- As of **7/10/2023**, Trumbull County has a case rate of **34.9** per 100,000. *Positivity Rate is no longer being quantified by the CDC.*

Overdose Information from the TCCHD

The TCCHD would like to share the following information with regard to National Overdose Awareness Day on 8-31-2023. Starting on 8-1 the courthouse in downtown Warren, Ohio, will be lit in *Purple* for the month of August. We will be placing *Purple* flags in courthouse square beginning on 8-21 through 9-1. There will be a *Purple* flag for each life lost, to the disease of addiction, in 2022 and 2023 to date. The TCCHD will also be hosting a "*Locks for Love*" event from 8-1 through 8-31. Individuals can come to the TCCHD to pick up a lock to which they can write their loved ones' name on and hook it to the fence downtown behind the log cabin. These locks will be on the fence from 8-1 through 9-1. Finally, on 8-31 The TCCHD will collaborate with ASAP and Trumbull County Mental Health and Recovery Board to distribute Narcan kits. We are currently recruiting additional agencies to distribute the kits and there will be more information coming as 8-31 gets closer on which agencies will be participating.

Know the Signs:

Signs and Symptoms of Heat Exhaustion:

- ✓ High body temperature
- High heart rate and low blood pressure,
- ✓ Dehydration and electrolyte loss
- ✓ Extreme weakness
- ✓ Trouble walking.
- ✓ Fainting, or light headedness
- Abdominal cramps, nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea,

Signs and Symptoms of Heat Stroke:

- ✓ High hody temperature
- ✓ Profuse sweating
- ✓ Headache
- ✓ Irrational behavior,
- ✓ Emotional instability
- ✓ Altered consciousness.
- Coma, or seizure.

Who is at risk:

Anyone, but those with the following are at a higher risk:

- High body mass index, or obesity
- ✓ Old age.
- Poor physical health,
- ✓ Sleep deprived.

Health conditions that predispose you to dehydration and malnutrition.

Rabies Info. From the TCCHD

Beginning July 31, 2023, the US Dept. of Agriculture and Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service Wildlife Services, along with the Ohio Department of Health and several Ohio local health departments, will begin distributing an oral rabies vaccine (ORV) by ground and aircraft to immunize wild raccoons in Trumbull County.

Contingent on good weather, the operation should be completed by August 25, 2023.

It is best to leave baits alone unless found in area where a child or pet might find it.

Wear gloves or use paper towel if you pick up a bait. There is no exposure risk in handling an intact bait. It is recommended that you wash your hands and any exposed skin thoroughly with soap and water after handling any rabies vaccine bait. Ingesting the vaccine will not harm your pet; however, vomiting and diarrhea have occurred in dogs that have ingested multiple baits.

(Quality in Action)

At the TTCHD half day staff training on 6-30-2023, the TCCHD quarterly update occurred for all of our Quality Improvement Endeavors. The following were a few key points taken away from all the data sources:

- According to the Quality Improvement
 Quarterly Efficiency Survey (2nd Quarter
 2023), nearly 80% of TCCHD staff Overall, are
 satisfied with the tools they currently have
 and use to perform their respective daily job
 duties. * This survey was revamped for the 3rd
 quarter however, and the results from such will
 differ in the next newsletter.
- The TCCHD QI Calendar is still being discussed and initially formatted by the administrative core team and will be released relatively soon,
- For 2023, TCCHD staff reports (via QI maturity survey) an aggregate 36% increase in understanding of all things QI being done in the TCCHD when compared to the same survey from 2022,
- The administrative core team is slated to discuss some possible candidates for upcoming quality improvement projects. The following are some potential topics that have been submitted over the past 24 months:

 - QI Monthly Contender and Champion,
 - Successorship/Mentorship participation, (no one has participated yet).

More Great News for the TCCHD and the Homeless Youth within Trumbull County

The TCCHD in collaboration with the Greater Warren-Youngstown Urban League's (GWYUL) Christy House Emergency Shelter (CHES) has been awarded a Youth Homelessness grant to prevent and end youth homelessness in Trumbull County. The aim of this grant and its subsequent work is to help roughly 50 youths who are experiencing homelessness in Trumbull County annually. This help will include, transitional housing, rapid re-housing, and emergency shelter. In addition to this great news, the grant also aligns with our community health assessment priority of addressing barriers around access to care, and the Community Health Improvement Plan objective of increasing access to care.
