Ohio Buckles Buckeyes (OBB) Program:

The Ohio Department of Health's child passenger safety (CPS) program, Ohio Buckles Buckeyes (OBB) provides child safety seats to eligible low income families. The overall goal of this program is to increase the availability of child safety seats for families who could not otherwise afford them and to increase correct installation and proper use of child safety seats.

Requirements for the Ohio Buckles Buckeyes Program:

In order to receive an OBB seat, income eligible families must attend an educational class provided by one of our own certified technicians. You are considered eligible for a free seat if your income is within the WIC guidelines (you do not need to be enrolled in WIC to receive a seat).
